COUNCIL THEREFORE FINDS [REDACTED] MD, guilty of professional misconduct under Section 56 (c) of the *Medical Act*, S.N.B. 1981, c. 87 in contravention of Regulation No. 9 of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that [REDACTED], MD be reprimanded and IT FURTHER ORDERED that said reprimand be without publication and without costs.

ALL OF WHICH HAVE BEEN DULY RESOLVED by Council as an Order of Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick, pursuant to the terms and provisions of the *Medical Act*, S.N.B. 1981, c. 87 and amendments thereto.
