ORDER OF COUNCIL

UPON THE MEETING OF THE COUNCIL on November 24th, 2017, at the City of Saint John, in the County of Saint John and Province of New Brunswick, with respect to the matter of Everette M. Hanson, M.D., of Oromocto; New Brunswick

UPON HAVING investigated an allegation of professional misconduct against Dr. Everette M. Hanson, M.D., respecting an improper relationship with a patient.

WHEREAS the parties have agreed to forego a proceeding by way of Board of Inquiry and proceed directly to Council:

AND WHEREAS Everette M. Hanson, M. D., has admitted, in writing, professional misconduct, said admission being filed with this Council;

COUNCIL THEREFORE FINDS Everette M. Hanson, M.D., guilty of professional misconduct under Section 56 (c) of the Medical Act, S. N. B. 1981, c. 87.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT Dr. Everette M. Hanson's licence to practise medicine be suspended for a period of eighteen months effective 1 January, 2018;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the last six months of such suspension will be held in abeyance so long as Dr. Hanson completes a professional ethics and boundary course acceptable to the College and does not otherwise engage in any professional misconduct.

ALL OF WHICH HAS BEEN DULY RESOLVED by Council as an Order of Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick, pursuant to the terms and provisions of the Medical Act, S.N.B. 1982, c.87.
