ORDER OF COUNCIL

UPON the meeting of Council on 9 June, 2000 in the Town of Dalhousie, New Brunswick with respect to the matter of [REDACTED] MD, of [REDACTED] New Brunswick;

UPON HAVING investigated an allegation of professional misconduct against [REDACTED], MD;

WHEREAS the parties have agreed to forego a proceeding by way of Board of Inquiry and proceed directly to Council:

AND WHEREAS [REDACTED] MD has admitted, in writing, professional misconduct, said admission being filed with this Council;

COUNCIL THEREFORE FINDS [REDACTED] MD, guilty of professional misconduct under Section 56 (c) of the *Medical Act*, S.N.B. 1981, c. 87 in contravention of Regulation No. 9 of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick, in that, on 3 December, 1999, he erred in his identification of a patient and, as a consequence, performed a procedure other than one for which there was consent.

AND UPON CONSIDERING the written submission of [REDACTED], MD, on his own behalf, with respect to both the admission of a guilty plea and penalty;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that [REDACTED] MD be reprimanded and IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said reprimand be without publication and without costs.

ALL OF WHICH HAVE BEEN DULY RESOLVED by Council as an Order of Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick, pursuant to the terms and provisions of the *Medical Act*, S.N.B. 1981, c. 87 and amendments thereto.
