AND UPON having considered the recommendations of the Board of Inquiry;

AND UPON considering the submission of Dr. [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] and of John P. Barry, Q.C., counsel for the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick, with respect to the issue of penalty;


**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that:

1. A reprimand be issued without the publication of Dr. [REDACTED]'s name;
2. Dr. [REDACTED]'s license be restricted to the practice of anaesthesia and related services;
3. The Review Committee be prepared to reconsider this restriction on Dr. [REDACTED] license, should he present adequate evidence of competence in the area of family practice;

and,

4. That Dr. [REDACTED] pay the costs of Council from August 1, 1998 to date, in an amount to be determined.
