IN THE MATTER OF DR. FLOYD DUNCAN MACDONALD

O R D E R O F C O U N C I L

UPON THE MEETING OF THE COUNCIL, on November 16, 1991 at the City of Saint John, New Brunswick, with respect to the matter of Dr. Floyd Duncan MacDonald;

AND UPON HEARING David G. O'Brien, legal counsel to the College;

AND UPON HEARING Rodney Gillis, Q.C., legal counsel to Dr. MacDonald;

AND UPON HEARING Dr. MacDonald and the Complainant;

AND UPON BEING ADVISED by Mr. Gillis that Dr. MacDonald admits professional misconduct by sexual impropriety with a patient in 1983 and 1984;

AND UPON BEING ADVISED by Mr. Gillis that Dr. MacDonald waives the benefit of interim procedures, prior to sentencing, in view of his admission of guilt;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT the admission of guilt by Dr. MacDonald with respect to his professional misconduct by sexual impropriety with a patient be, and is hereby accepted by Council, and the Council finds Dr. MacDonald to be guilty of professional misconduct;

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the license to practise medicine in the province of New Brunswick of Dr. Floyd Duncan MacDonald shall be suspended for a period of one year, commencing December 16, 1991;

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT with respects to costs of the Council, that Dr. Floyd Duncan MacDonald be ordered to pay the costs of the Council as agreed by consent order or taxed by the Registrar of the Court of Queens' Bench of New Brunswick as between solicitor and client.

AND FURTHER, THAT with respect to publication of penalty, the name of Dr. Floyd Duncan MacDonald may be published and the public informed that he has been found guilty of professional misconduct as defined under the Medical Act, specifically professional misconduct on the basis of sexual impropriety with an adult female patient. For this, it has been ordered by the Council that his license to practise medicine shall be suspended for a period of one year commencing December 16, 1991.

ALL OF WHICH HAS BEEN DULY RESOLVED by Council as an Order of the Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick, pursuant to the terms and provisions of the Medical Act, S.N.B. 1981, c.-87
