**IN THE MATTER OF ALEXANDRE LUBIN, M.D.**

**ORDER OF COUNCIL**

**UPON THE MEETING OF THE COUNCIL** on November 29, 2019, at the City of Saint John, in the County of Saint John and Province of New Brunswick, with respect to the matter of Alexandre Lubin, M.D., of Miramichi, New Brunswick.

**UPON HAVING** investigated an allegation of professional misconduct against Dr. Alexandre Lubin, M.D., respecting interactions with a former patient that crossed professional boundaries.

**AND WHEREAS** the parties have agreed to forego a proceeding by way of Board of Inquiry and proceed directly to Council.

**AND WHEREAS** Alexandre Lubin, M.D., has admitted, in writing, professional misconduct, said admission being filed with this Council.

**COUNCIL THEREFORE FINDS** Alexandre Lubin, M.D., guilty of professional misconduct under Section 56 (c) of the *Medical Act*, S. N. B. 1981, c. 87.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT** Alexandre Lubin's, M.D., licence to practise medicine be suspended for a period of twelve (12) months effective November 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019.


