

APPENDIX A-OTHER REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

This professional standard sets out a registrant's duty to report under the *Medical Act* and its regulations. In addition to the reporting requirements set out in this professional standard, registrants are required to report other concerns to other health regulatory bodies or government entities. Below is a list of other reporting requirements. This compilation is not exhaustive and is provided for reference purposes only. The list does not encompass all reporting obligations that may arise under institutional or hospital policies, or specific program requirements. Registrants are advised to seek independent legal advice should they encounter circumstances that may present ethical or legal complexities.
